Ballet Moves

KINDERGARTEN, PREP – YR 2

Movement concepts are introduced in a playful and creative way through exploration of an Australian story, igniting imaginations and bringing the narrative to life.

Moving to Learn

YR 2 – 6

Learn the basics of coding through dance. This workshop explores connections between how we can program a robot and how we can instruct, or choreograph, our bodies to move.

Nutcracker Repertoire

YR 3 – 6

Based on the much-loved ballet *The Nutcracker*, students will learn adapted repertoire from Ben Stevenson's production to experience cultural dance.

Ballet History and Technique

YR 7 – 10

The history and evolution of ballet will be incorporated into the teaching of this class, culminating in learning repertoire from different eras.

Partnering

YR 7 – 10

Students will be guided through basic partnering skills that are then integrated into the learning of a duet from a contemporary ballet.
